Early Morning and Dismissal Procedures

Drop-off will begin at 8:15 AM every day. Please do not drop your child off before 8:15 AM, as there will be no supervision prior to that time. During drop-off students should exit their cars and proceed to one of four entrances for temperature checks based on the grade level that they are in. The entrances will be marked for your convenience and they are:

Elementary main entrance (Grade K-2 students)

Front of linking hallway (Grade 3 & 4 students)

Middle school main entrance (Grade 5 & 6 students)

Middle school/band room hallway entrance (Grade 7 & 8 students)

For health and safety reasons we must limit the number of people who are on school premises. Parents may not exit their car. The only exception will be for kindergarten parents, who will be permitted to walk their child to the K-2 entrance.

If you will be walking your child to school be advised that you must wear a mask at all times while on school premises. Please be respectful and responsible in regard to social distancing and do not congregate on school premises after dropping your child off. We ask that you take pictures at home and prepare your child for his/her first day prior to your arrival at school. There will be staff members to supervise students as they have their temperature taken and enter the school building.

At dismissal (12:30 PM) students will exit the school through their exterior classroom doors (Grades K-3) and the front and rear of the school building (Grades 4-8). Please discuss with your child a designated pick-up location so that he/she is aware of where to go to meet you. Social distancing guidelines are in effect during pick-up and all parents are encouraged to keep a safe distance from others when picking up their child. Please be respectful and responsible in regard to social distancing and do not congregate on school premises after picking up your child. Our playgrounds will be closed to all students and parents until further notice and should not be used after school.

Remote Learning Expectations

Students will follow their Genesis schedules and log on for each class through the content area teacher's Google Classroom link. Students must have cameras turned on to be considered present for each class.

- All students should wear headphones for the duration of the video conference.
- All students should be in a public place of their home such as a living room or kitchen.
- Students should keep their microphone muted until called upon by the teacher.
- Students will indicate their desire to ask a question by clicking the button to raise their hand.
- Students will bring their best behavior to the virtual learning environment. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Only using the chat feature for conversations/questions pertaining to the class/lesson
 - Joining the Google Meet only after a teacher has started the Google Meet
- All students must have their camera turned on during class. If a student has a problem with his/her camera, it must be immediately reported to the classroom teacher. Taking screenshots or using contrived methods to manipulate the camera and portray attendance will not be tolerated.
- Recording Google Meet sessions for any reason is strictly prohibited.
- Sharing passwords, class codes, Meet links with anyone inside or outside our school environment is considered a violation of our Acceptable Use Policy and will be met with school based consequences.

Masks and Social Distancing

The health and safety of our staff and students is our main priority. We will work with all our students to ensure a safe environment for learning that follows all CDC guidelines.

- Students are required to wear a properly fitted face covering (a face covering that covers both their nose and mouth) while on school premises.
- A student's refusal to wear a mask who does not have an approved medical exemption or accommodation, may result in disciplinary action, including possibly being required to participate in fully remote learning.
