SPECIAL EDUCATION EVALUATIONS
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2468 – SPECIAL EDUCATION EVALUATIONS

Evaluations of students suspected of being eligible for special education and related services, or as part of a reevaluation, shall be in compliance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 6A:14-2.5(a) and (b), N.J.A.C. 6A:14-3.4, and N.J.A.C. 6A:14-3.8, as appropriate. The District may utilize an employee of the District, shared services agreement, another public school district, educational services commission, jointure commission, or a clinic or agency approved under N.J.A.C. 6A:14-5, or an independent contractor to conduct the evaluations agreed upon by the evaluation planning committee. Since relevant criteria regarding the evaluations, including the maximum allowable cost, may change, the Board delegates the authority to establish said criteria to the Superintendent and Supervisor of Special Education. The Superintendent and Supervisor of Special Education shall promulgate regulations consistent with this Policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:14 et seq., which shall be reviewed at least annually.
