**TESTING
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2622.2 TESTING

The school district shall establish and maintain an annual testing program which can be used, communicated and interpreted by school and by district.

The district testing program shall embody at least the tests required by State Law. School personnel shall not use tests, procedures or other guidance and counseling materials which are differentiated or stereotyped on the basis of race, color, creed, region, sex, ancestry, national origin or social or economic status.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures for a comprehensive testing program which shall include the following:

1. A list of those tests which will be administered to the students of this district shall be presented to the Board annually, along with an explanation of how each such test will contribute to the educational program.
2. Parents/guardians shall be informed of the testing program of the school and of the special tests which are to be administered to their children.
3. Data regarding individual test scores shall be entered on the student's cumulative record, where it shall be subject to the policies of this Board regarding student records.
4. The testing program shall be continually evaluated for its effectiveness in helping to meet the needs of the district.
