HONORING PUPIL ACHIEVEMENT
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5440 - HONORING STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The Board of Education has long held that student achievement should be publicly recognized at all levels in a manner appropriate to the student's accomplishment. Public recognition on honor rolls and at assemblies shall all be part of this effort.

Honor Roll Requirements

All honor roll students must have A's (90-100) and B's (82-89) in non-academic areas as well as academic subjects.

High Honor Roll Requirements

All high honor roll students must have A's (90-100) in non-academic areas as well as academic subjects.

National Junior Honor Society

To be eligible for nomination to National Junior Honor Society, all eighth grade students must have achieved a cumulative average of 92 in the five core academic courses (Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies, World Language) by the end of the third trimester of the previous year. The faculty committee, then considers the students eligible for nomination on the merits of leadership, character, scholarship, and citizenship for final recommendation. To maintain membership, in the eighth grade, students must continue to hold at least a 92 average throughout the year and continue to honor the values of exemplary citizenship.

The Board is appreciative of the generosity of organizations which offer scholarships or prizes to deserving students in this district. But, in accepting the offer such scholarships or prizes, the Board directs that the type of scholarship or prize, and any restrictions upon it, shall be approved by the Superintendent.
