5466 PROMOTION AND YEARBOOK FEES

The Board of Education recognizes that the cost of promotion ceremonies, if any, directly paid by promoting pupils and the cost of a yearbook directly paid by the promoting pupil may create a financial hardship for the parent, legal guardian or other person having legal custody of the pupil.

The Board of Education will not exclude from the promotion ceremony any pupil who is unable to pay the fees required of the pupil to participate in the ceremony because of financial hardship for the parent, legal guardian or other person having legal custody of the pupil.

Furthermore, the Board will pay the cost for a promoting pupil to purchase a yearbook if the pupil is unable to pay the fees required of the pupil to participate in the ceremony because of financial hardship for the parent, legal guardian or other person having legal custody of the pupil.

In determining financial hardship, the criteria will be the same as the Statewide eligibility standards established by the State Board of Education for free and reduced price meals under the State School Lunch Program.
