5111.1 FOREIGN EXCHANGE PUPILS

The Board recognizes the cultural benefits of foreign exchange student programs and authorizes the Superintendent to accept foreign exchange students into the school (not to exceed a three month period) on a tuition free basis in accordance with the guidelines outlined below.

1. The foreign exchange student shall possess a reasonable facility of the English language;
2. Applications shall be screened by the school Principal to determine if there is an appropriate program available for the pupil;
3. Pupils shall be considered for acceptance prior to the fourth quarter of the school year and enrolled on a space available basis, subject to size of classes;
4. Pupils shall be subject to all policies and regulations governing the conduct and behavior of resident pupils;
5. Pupils shall maintain passing grades in all subjects as well as satisfactory discipline and attendance records;
6. Pupils shall not participate in the Eighth Grade Promotion Ceremony and/or receive a diploma;
7. Resident host families shall provide a notarized letter accepting responsibility for the pupil and verifying that they are serving as a volunteer host family without personal profit; and
8. A limit of two pupils per program may be accepted each year with a total limit of four pupils at one time.
