## **5411.1 PROMOTION CEREMONY**

It is the policy of the Northvale Board of Education that any student who is in danger of failure of a course, or multiple courses, resulting in retention at the same grade level or failure to be promoted to high school be given sufficient warnings.

Parents will have a conference with the Superintendent if their child is in danger of loss of promotion privileges.

Disciplinary action can also result in the loss of promotion ceremony participation, including attendance by the student and his/her family at the ceremony subject to the determination by the Superintendent.

Students ineligible to participate in the promotion ceremony due to academic or disciplinary reasons will not have their names read at the ceremony for promotion, awards, or honors.

Eighth grade students who fail two or more courses will not participate in the ceremony.
