## R 5514 PUPIL USE OF VEHICLES

### A. Use of bicycles

The use of bicycles for travel to and from school by pupils in grades three through eight is permitted in accordance with Policy No. 5514 and the following rules.

1. Bicycles must be in sound condition and equipped with
  - a. A rear reflector;
  - b. A bell or other signaling device other than a siren or whistle;
  - c. Brakes;
  - d. A lock and chain; and
  - e. If the bicycle will be used after dark, a white front lamp and red rear lamp, each visible from at least 500 feet.
2. The operator may not permit a second person to ride on the bicycle with him or her.
3. The operator will keep his or her hands on the handlebars and feet on the pedals while the bicycle is being operated on the street.
4. The operator will not "hitch" a ride on any moving vehicle.
5. The operator will walk the bicycle while on school premises.
6. The operator will store his or her bicycle in a rack provided at the school. Pupils are advised to keep bicycles locked when not in use.
7. The operator will wear a biker's helmet.
