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R 9190 COMMUNITY RESOURCES

The Northvale Board of Education encourages residents who are especially qualified because of training, experience, interest, or personal characteristics to take an active part in the district's educational programs. Those persons identified by the Superintendent and the staff and approved by the Board may be invited to act as advisors in groups or individually in:

- A. Clarifying the general ideas and attitudes held by district residents in regard to the schools, or to particular programs in the schools;
- B. Determining the purposes of courses of study and special services;
- C. Evaluating the extent to which these purposes are being achieved;
- D. Giving active assistance to the teaching staff in the operation of classes and services where the Superintendent, in consultation with the teaching staff, has deemed such aid appropriate and valuable;
- E. Identifying and solving specific school-district problems; and the
- F. Operation of special programs over and above the regular district curriculum.

The schools shall also take advantage of the physical resources of the community and other organizations when such facilities or locations provide learning opportunities not otherwise available to our students. Safety of students shall be a primary concern in utilizing such resources.

In accordance with law, the administration shall identify and establish working relationships with community agencies which are involved in evaluation and treatment of drug/alcohol problems.

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
