**REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS
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R 5420 – REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop procedures where by parents/guardians of pupils will be notified regularly of their child's progress toward achievement of individual and district goals and objectives. Consideration should be given to the use of a variety of procedures such as parent-teacher conferences, report cards, and other formal and informal methods.

These procedures must included, but not be limited to:

- A. Provision for a translator if the parent/guardian's primary language is other than English;
- B. A district-wide grading system for comparable grade levels. The system shall be both diagnostic and objective;
- C. Scheduling of individual parent-teacher conferences at the elementary and secondary level.
